- Scholarships are granted for the current school year only and do not include the months of June, July, and August. Students must reapply each year.
- Satisfactory progress and attendance must be made in each and every lesson. Students receiving lesson scholarships must practice and be prepared. Unsatisfactory performance could result in the scholarship being revoked. The SPHS band directors will monitor and will have final authority over any and all scholarships.
- Enrollment in the IMIP Program, whether on scholarship or not, does not guarantee a specific position in any musical performance organization.
- If a student is on partial scholarship, payment from the parent must be made directly to the private lesson teacher (preferably at the beginning of each month for the entire month), not the SPHS Band office.
