REQUIRED ITEMS

A. Band Assessment - This modest fee is required yearly of all RRISD high school band students. The fee helps to finance the drill writing and music arrangement of the marching band production. Additionally, excess funds help to provide honorariums for guest clinicians to work with our students in both the Fall and Spring semesters.

B. Summer Instruction Fee - This fee pays for the contracted services of our marching, percussion and color guard technicians for the months of June, July and August. The addition of these technicians during the summer help us to reduce our student to instructor ratio in order to streamline the teaching of the marching fundamentals.

C. Uniform Cleaning/Alteration - Both the marching and concert uniforms are provided by SPHS. Pants, sleeves and dress hems will need to be altered to fit your student. Due to the uniforms being school property, parents are not allowed to alter the uniform themselves. This fee covers those alterations as well as the cleaning of the concert uniform cleaning at the end of the school year.

D. Marching Shoes - Every marching band member must wear these black marching shoes. The shoe is specifically designed to suit the needs of a marching band member and can only be purchased through certain band vendors. Purchasing in bulk, we receive a significant discount.

E. Garment Bag - This durable Stony Point Garment Bag protects our uniform when we travel. Purchased during the freshman year, the bag should last through their senior year. For Color Guard a tote bag is ordered. Marching band students may purchase a tote bag for an additional fee (\$35)

F. Summer Uniform - These shorts and shirts are worn under the uniform in order for us to remain in a uniformed appearance

when we remove the formal marching uniform at competitions and other performances.

G. Water Jug Cover - Students will need to provide a water jug for themselves for rehearsals and performances. The jug should

hold 1/2 of water (not gallon). For performances, students will use this jug cover to maintain a uniform appearance in the stands.

H. Contest Entry Fees - This fee covers the student entry into marching contests throughout the season. (Note: this fee does not cover the accompanist required for soloists.)

With proper care, this one purchase can last all four years of high school.
