

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES – STONY POINT BAND

Everything Day – Volunteers are needed to help staff stations throughout the day and help parents through the lines. There are several areas and stations to cover over the course of the day, such as a volunteer sign up station, a band registration station, a meal order station (for pre-game and competition meals), merchandise sales, uniform fitting, and more!

Mattress Sale – CFS handles the sale, but we need volunteers to supervise students who are advertising the event in front of the school.

Festival of Bands – This is a district-wide showcase of all of the RRISD middle school and high school bands usually held in the first week of October. There is no bus service to this event; students will need a ride to and from Kelly Reeves Stadium. Volunteers from each of the five band booster programs in RRISD are needed to help run concession stands, sell tickets, hand out programs, etc.

Band Family Picnic – This is one of the first social gatherings of the school year. The boosters provide hamburgers or hot dogs, and the band family provides items like chips, desserts, and fruit. It's a great time getting to know everyone. We need parents to volunteer to set up, serve, and clean up.

Ice Cream Social – What a great way to end a summer practice! The boosters provide the ice cream, and band students provide the toppings (by section). We need parents to set up, serve, and clean up.

Band Car Wash – This is our first big fundraiser of the year. We assign students to work at one of five car wash sites in town, and they scrub cars all morning to raise money for the band. The site that raises the most money wins a prize! We need parents to serve as site captains to oversee each car wash team.

Chaperones – We need dedicated band parents or family members to serve as chaperones for games, competitions, and other events. Chaperones ride on the buses with the students and must be confident about making sure our kids follow the rules. Adults who volunteer to be a chaperone must register with the school district and consent to a background check. We also need a committee chairperson to oversee this committee and organize and train the volunteers.

Concessions – Our concession stands raise the most money over all of our fundraising. Because concessions are important, we have to ensure that every time we are responsible for running a concession stand, we have enough volunteers. Every band family is required to work a minimum of 3 games, and one playoff game. No experience is necessary, and even though we say it's work, it's actually a blast! The Concessionaire, a band booster officer, oversees this committee. Stand managers are needed to help run concession stands at games, in addition to concession stand volunteers.

Game Day/Competition Meals – The boosters feed the band before every football game and every marching competition during the fall. Please note: we do not feed the kids before Festival of Bands. We need parents to volunteer to distribute food to students and clean up. We also need a committee chairperson to oversee this committee and place food orders and arrange pickup or delivery.

Pit Crew/Equipment Crew – We need parents to volunteer to help load the equipment trucks before games/competitions, unload equipment at the stadium, help the front ensemble get their equipment onto the football field, load it all back up, and unload at the school after the game/competition. Crew

members also pick up the rental truck(s) and return them after use. We also need a committee chair to oversee this committee and organize volunteers.

Prop Crew – Like the equipment crew, the prop crew will load and unload props at games and competitions. Crew members also participate in building props and getting props to the field and off the field. A committee chair is also needed to oversee this committee and organize volunteers.

Uniforms – Volunteers are needed to help with uniform fittings, assigning uniform compartments to each student, minor uniform alterations and repair, and washing/cleaning of uniforms.

Scholarship Committee – We need volunteers to review scholarship applications and score them based on a rubric.

Nomination Committee – Volunteers review nominees who wish to hold executive board positions to determine eligibility and present candidates for voting at a general meeting.

Finance Committee – Volunteers will assist the Treasurer with various tasks, such as helping to make deposits after football games, assisting with year-end audits, and any other miscellaneous duties assigned by the Treasurer.

Fundraising Committee – Volunteers will assist the 1st Vice President with fundraising tasks, such as helping set up Restaurant Spirit Nights, merchandise sales, and any other miscellaneous duties assigned by the 1st Vice President.

US Bands – Each year in early November, the Stony Point Band hosts the US Bands Remo Series Finale marching competition at Kelly Reeves Stadium. Bands come from all over the state to compete, and as the host school, it is our responsibility to organize and run this event. This competition requires participation from ALL of our band families to volunteer at various stations throughout the day.

COMMITTEE CHAIRS – We need parent volunteers to head these committees and report any important information or needs to the executive board. Below are examples of some of the committees that need a lead, or chairperson; however, any parent can offer to lead any committee or event. Just ask!

OTHER IMPORTANT VOLUNTEER POSITIONS – We need parents to fill these other important positions to assist executive board members with their respective committees.

STAND MANAGERS – assist the Concessionaire by managing concession stands at middle school, freshman, JV, and varsity football games.

FUNDRAISING COMMITTEE – assist the 1st Vice President with setting up restaurant spirit nights, ordering and distributing merchandise, selling merchandise at football games and events.

FINANCE COMMITTEE – assist the Treasurer with collecting money from concession stands after a football game and make bank deposit; assist with year-end audit; assist during Everything Day with band registration and payment collection.

Each year the booster board tries new fundraising ideas, and the needs of the band can change from year-to-year. Volunteering needs will also change as a result. As new volunteer opportunities arise, we ask that our band family be ready to rise to the occasion and volunteer.

EXECUTIVE BOARD - APPOINTED POSITIONS AVAILABLE

BCOB Representative

- Attend monthly BCOB (Band Concessions Operating Board) meetings.
- Coordinate with other BCOB Representatives from the other RRISD band programs the responsibilities to stock and maintain the concession stands at Dragon Stadium and Kelly Reeves Stadium, including ordering and stocking food/supplies.
- Attend monthly executive board meetings to give report from BCOB meetings and coordinate any necessary action from the executive board and/or Concessionaire.
- Volunteer to help on committees.
- Assist with training of Stand Managers with BCOB standards.

USBands Coordinator

- Oversee all committees and committee chairpersons participating in the annual USBands competition that Stony Point hosts at Kelly Reeves Stadium.
- Work closely with 2nd Vice President to ensure all stations are staffed with volunteers for the entire day.
- Work closely with Concessionaire and BCOB Representative to ensure that food and drink levels are adequate for this event.
- Oversee hospitality for adjudicators, volunteers, and band directors.
- Secure hiring of EMT for duration of event.
- Oversee set up and take down/clean up of event.
- Coordinate dumpster rental with RRISD Custodial Department.
- Work with RRISD security and Williamson County Sherriff's Department to ensure the security of all attendees of the event.
- Serve on the fundraising committee throughout the school year to assist 1st Vice President with various tasks associated with fundraising.
